MISSION OPPORTUNITY

Stay Warm Shelter

Stay Warm Shelter (SWS) is a program for the unhoused in Gallatin and Hendersonville. It is located at First Baptist Winchester in Gallatin. SWS offers the homeless the opportunity for a warm place to stay/fellowship on Friday nights in the months of January and February. They also provide meal delivery on Friday nights to individuals who prefer to stay in their own location.

**Rehoboth has volunteered to provide a meal for 70 guests on Friday, January 14,
and Volunteers are needed:**

1. Eight volunteers are needed to provide warm food and delivery to the Stay Warm Shelter. Each volunteer will make the same dish (a recipe will be provided). Samples of possible main dish items include pasta with meat sauce, stew, chili, chicken and dumplings, chicken casserole, etc. The food will be portioned into individual 16 oz. containers.
2. Also eight volunteers are needed to work with SWS to assemble 70 food bags for delivery or consumption on site between 7 and 10 pm that evening. These volunteers will also help set up the overnight shelter for the men and women.
