COVENANT Bible Study guides small groups through a comprehensive, in-depth study of the whole Bible over twenty-four sessions broken into three modules—each dealing with a different aspect of what covenant means: Creating, Living and Trusting. This study differs from other Bible studies in that it emphasizes the biblical concept of covenant as a unifying pattern throughout the entire Bible. The program covers both Testaments—discussing books from each in a way that shows the interconnectedness of scripture as a whole.

Each Covenant Bible Study participant will need a Participant Guide and a Bible. The single volume Participant Guide contains the materials required for all three modules. It walks study participants through the daily scripture readings and offers space to interact personally with the readings, the group experience, and the weekly meditations.

The Participant Guide is on sale through Cokesbury at this time, but is also available through Amazon.
