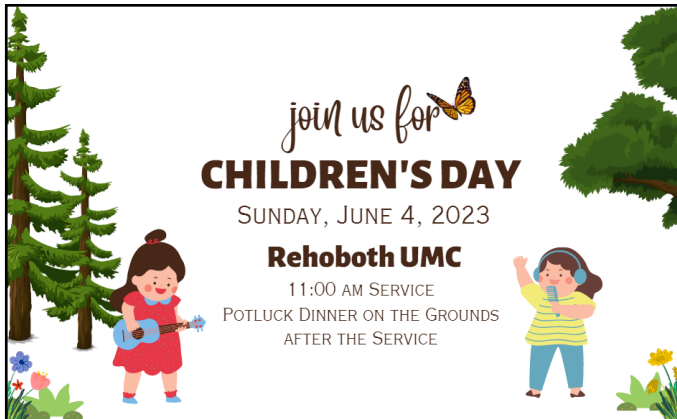

We hope the information covered during this meeting will provide answers and reduce confusion regarding these topics.

2023 Stewardship Audit Report

Dale Eckler of Eckler Consulting LLC recently completed our Stewardship Audit, which included a very detailed examination of all 2022 financial transactions. Each deposit and each disbursement for all accounts was examined, and auditing standards developed specifically for churches were utilized. These standards are designed to assess the overall cash management process to determine if the funds received and the persons who handle these funds are adequately protected. Mr. Eckler's positive report concluded:

As a result of the continued adherence to the Financial Policies and Procedures that have been implemented, I found no evidence to suspect that funds have been misused.
